Several years ago, I was diagnosed with Stage 4 ovarian cancer and given a grim prognosis. I began to live with more intentionality, trying to do what mattered most: spending quality time with my husband, children and grandchildren and others I love. I had to give up most of my job responsibilities at the ministry of MOPS (Mothers of Preschoolers) International where I'd been writing books and encouraging moms of young children.

I prayed God would show me the purpose of my life in this unexpected season. I began meeting with other people who also faced challenges in their lives. As we talked, I found how life-giving and hope-bringing our stories are. Soon, I helped launch and lead a **Stories...** ministry at the First Presbyterian Church in Boulder where women gather regularly to hear authentic stories of challenge and change. Guess what? I've beaten the odds so far and I'm now calling myself a cancer survivor as God keeps nudging me forward in this ministry of stories. I believe He is making me useful in his hands.
